"TC: halte à la haine sur Internet" "Training course: Haine no hate online"

The proliferation of hateful contents on Internet undermines the idea of «living together democratically» and make us wonder whether the existing legal mechanisms are really effective or not.

The proliferation of hate speeches entails some risks: it can leads to an increase in conflicts between groups and communities.

Insults, aggressions, racism, anti-semitism, homophobia, hatred appeals...

In 2015, the 27% of the millions of comments posted on news websites and Facebook have been removed. Is more than 1 over 4 comments.

This is a figure that is steadily increasing and which raises the issue of efforts to fight cyberviolence both at school and in business.

This course is designed for young workers who want to learn more about online hate speeches.

The goal of the training is to learn about the tools and methods to treat this problem, and work



with young people to combat online hate speeches.

What are the online hate speeches?

Online hate speeches are texts, words, images, videos and symbols used to spread hate, to threaten and to incite violence in Internet against a person or a group.

Intolerance and xenophobia are growing alarmingly and hate speeches are becoming more frequent, particularly on Internet.

Young people are the most active users of new technologies and social media, and they are directly concerned both as agents and victims of online hate speeches.

Training's Goals and Objectives

- Learning more about hate speeches, especially about online hate speeches.
- Using human rights education activities to fight hate speeches and the risks that they represent for democracy and for the welfare of young people;
- Learning about concrete tools to counteract hate, including a training regarding the appropriate use of Internet
- Receiving information on the Erasmus + Youth in Action program on this issue
- Planning and developing educational follow-up activities, multiplier events or campaign activities.

Profile of participants

- Youth workers who would like to work on the fight against hate speeches in their future work
- Participants should be in contact with other young people within their own organizations, workplaces.
- Participants must be fluent in English and French as working languages.
- Participants should be prepared to keep in touch and cooperate with national anti-hate speeches institutions.
- Participants must be prepared to plan and implement a follow-up activity or multiplier event after the seminar.

From PARIS

Airport Charles De Gaulles : Shuttles every 30 minutes to Montparnasse station

You can also take the train from the station Roissy Charles De Gaulle to ANGOULÊME (VIA cognac by train).

Bauvais Airport: You will take the bus to Porte Maillot for 13€ and it takes 1h - 1h15 mins.

Take the metro line 1 in the direction of Château de Vincennes from Porte Maillot to Charles de Gaulle - étoile and change the line there and get to the line 6 in the direction of Nation and go to Montparnasse Bienvenue.

Gare Montparnasse: Take the TGV (High Speed Train) to ANGOULÊME Station.

From Bordeaux Airport:

- Shuttle to Bordeaux Saint Jean Station
- From Bordeaux Saint Station to COGNAC by TRAIN

You can have cheaper train tickets with the OUIGO internet platform. And you will have a train to Angoulême.
